



Information Collection and Use

RocketTXT is the sole owner of the information collected on this site. We will not sell, share, or rent this information to others in ways different from what is disclosed in this statement. RocketTXT collects information from our users at several different points on our website.

Registration

In order to use this website, a user must first complete the registration form. During registration a user is required to give their contact information (such as name and email address). This information is used to contact the user about the services on our site for which they have expressed interest.

Cookies

A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's hard drive containing information about the user. Usage of a cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information while on our site. Once the user closes their browser, the cookie simply terminates. For instance, by setting a cookie on our site, the user would not have to log in a password more than once, thereby saving time while on our site. RocketTXT website will log people out of a secure session after 2 hours of inactivity by a user.

Log Files

We use IP addresses to analyse trends, administer the site, track user's movements), and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses are not linked to personally identifiable information.

Sharing

We do not share aggregated demographic information with partners or advertisers.

We encourage our users to be aware when they leave our site and to read the privacy statements of each and every web site that collects personally identifiable information. Security

This website takes every precaution to protect our users' information. When users submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and off-line.

When our registration/order form asks users to enter sensitive information (such as credit card number), that information is encrypted and is protected with industry-standard strong encryption (SSL). While on a secure page, such as our order form, the lock icon on the bottom of Web browsers such as Netscape Navigator and Microsoft Internet Explorer becomes locked, as opposed to un-locked, or open, when you are just 'surfing'.

While we use SSL encryption to protect sensitive information online, we also do everything in our power to protect user-information off-line. All of our users' information, not just the sensitive information mentioned above, is restricted in our offices. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, our billing clerk or a customer service representative) are granted access to personally identifiable information. Our employees must use password-protected screen-savers when they leave their desk. When they return, they must re-enter their password to re-gain access to your information. Furthermore, ALL employees are kept up-to-date on our security and privacy practices. Every quarter, as well as any time new policies are added, our employees are notified and/or reminded about the importance we place on privacy and what they can do to ensure our customers' information is protected. Finally, the servers that we store personally identifiable information on are kept in a secure environment, behind a locked door.

Users of the RocketTXT Messaging Service must realise that although RocketTXT employs high levels of security, no data transmission over the internet can be 100% safe.

Therefore, use of RocketTXT Messaging is at the client's own risk.

Furthermore, users must be aware that sending messages with RocketTXT will have a similar level of security and reliability as that of Mobile Phone Networks.
